Travel

For your GPS, our address is 2 Fitz Hugh Lane, Mount Desert, ME. 04660. Hotels are only 4 miles away in Bar Harbor, and Trenton. The motel quite a few have used in the past is the Eden Brook across from the College of the Atlantic in Bar Harbor, Telephone # 207-288-4975, the rates are reasonable & refrigerators are available for a small fee. Also, Trenton, just before you cross the bridge to Mount Desert Island, has a reasonably priced one named Sunrise, 207-667-8452, or go on line, the area has many options. Any questions, just ask!

The house water is safe to drink. **If you want Soda, or any drinks other than Tea and Coffee please bring them, we will provide plastic glasses and ice.** Coffee and snacks will be available all day. I assure you no one will go hungry! For Supper, after classes are over, there is a very good BBQ restaurant within 2 miles and a convenience store that has sandwiches [subway] and pizza, 1 mile up the road. Ellsworth is the nearest city, 18 miles, Bar Harbor, 6 miles, and Southwest Harbor, 10 miles and Northeast Harbor, 6 miles. All of them have many restaurants & hotels

Art Show

There is a \$5.00 fee, per item, which will be used for prize money to be paid for the first place, second place, Judges, & Peoples choices winners. We have 2 categories this year; a Christmas category, & a Painting category. For the Painting Category you may enter a up to a 9"x12" painting **ready to hang**. If you want to enter a larger painting, frame a photo of it. For the Christmas category, you may enter an item that is up to 108" square less. ie; An ornament, flat decorated wreath or tree or hand sewed item, etc. that can be hung or standalone. **(To get the square inches, take the height of the item and the width of the item and multiply them. For instance if it is 17" high and 6" wide that will be a total of 102"sq. a small wreath that is 10"x10" from edge to edge is a total of 100"sq.)** Space to display is somewhat limited. You may enter one in each category. Any questions, please contact Betty Allen.
