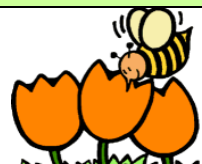
Sunshine corner continued:

For Painting: Table easel, paper towels, water container, palettes and palette paper for oil, acrylic and water color large enough for many colors and mixing space, masking and scotch tape, favorite brushes and palette knives, notebook, pencil, and Sharpie pen.

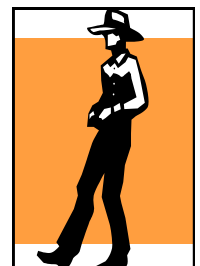

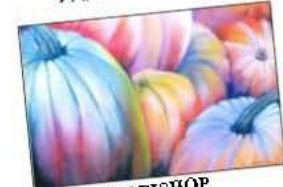
