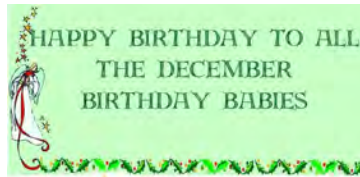

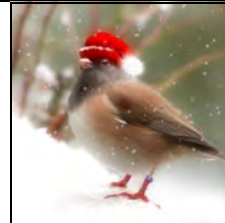
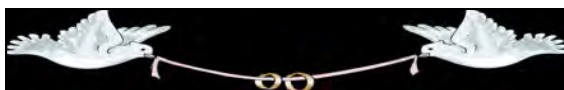
## CIRCLE OF CONCERN

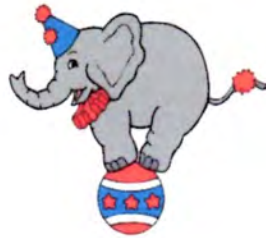

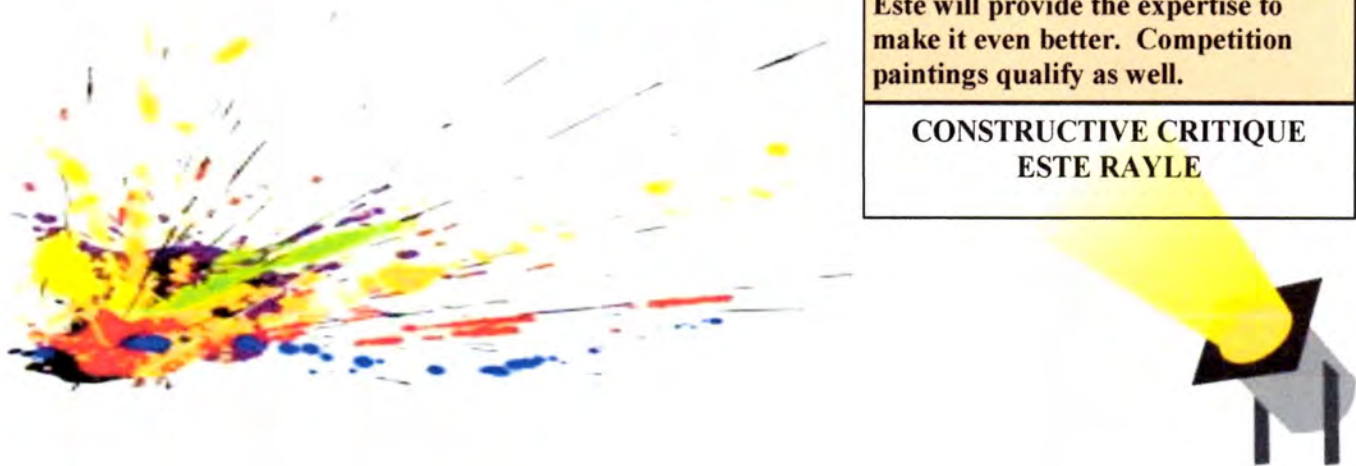
