FREE ONLINE PACKETS.

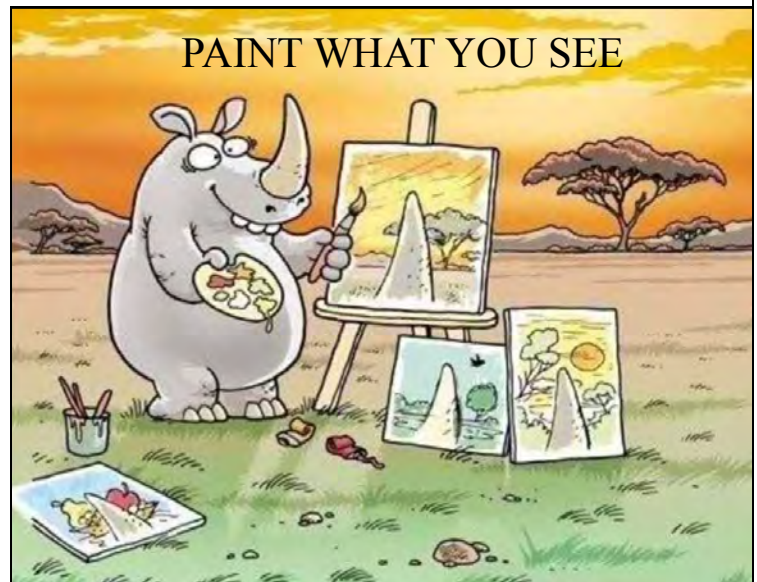
